In 2022, the community's determination helped us reach new milestones and moved us closer to our vision of a world without eczema.

Community

Reach individuals earlier in their care journey, connect them to professionals and peers and inspire them to participate in the mission.



Welcomed the community back together for in-person Eczema Expo after two years of virtual Expo, with **579 total registrants**.



10 of 10 respondents said they would recommend Expo to others.

Knowledge

Generate and promote eczema information, research and resources, the serious and heterogeneous nature of eczema and the burdens it imposes, and improve treatment and management of eczema across the lifespan.



Promoted NEA's real-world data program with **6 new peer-reviewed publications, 12 scientific abstracts** and **oral presentations** and **7 manuscripts** in development based on NEA research surveys.



Awarded \$730,000 in Research Grants to 13 recipients, a 42% increase in grant funding over 2021.



Launched the **AD Visual Guide**, a first of its kind tool to highlight the variation in appearance of eczema across skin tones.



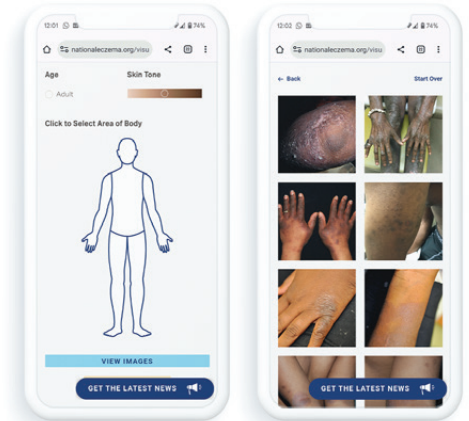
Received **2 top Platinum eHealthcare Leadership Awards** for EczemaWise: Best Care/Disease Management App and Best Mobile App



Reached nearly **10,000 registered EczemaWise users**, representing a 45% increase over 2021.

Collective Action

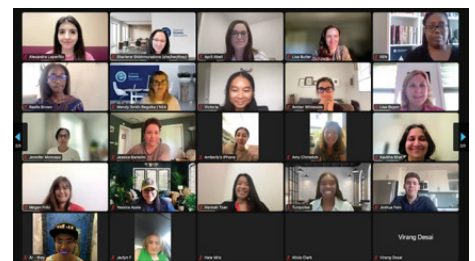

Held **first Virtual Hill Day** with NEA Ambassadors participating in over **100 meetings** with members of Congress.



Secured **six new cosponsors of the Safe Step Act**, which helps ensure access to treatments.
